Flowers Gallery is pleased to announce the 37th edition of the annual *Small is Beautiful* exhibition.

Small is Beautiful was first established at Flowers Gallery in 1974, presenting works by selected contemporary artists at a fixed scale, each piece measuring no more than 7 x 9 inches (18 x 23 cm).

On display will be more than 100 works by invited British and international artists, offering a rare opportunity to purchase smaller pieces by well-known names and discover new talents working across a range of media.

Artists selected to participate in *Small is Beautiful* for the first time include English novelist Mark Haddon, best known for *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time* (2003); and newly represented artist Stuart Pearson-Wright who joins the gallery this year.

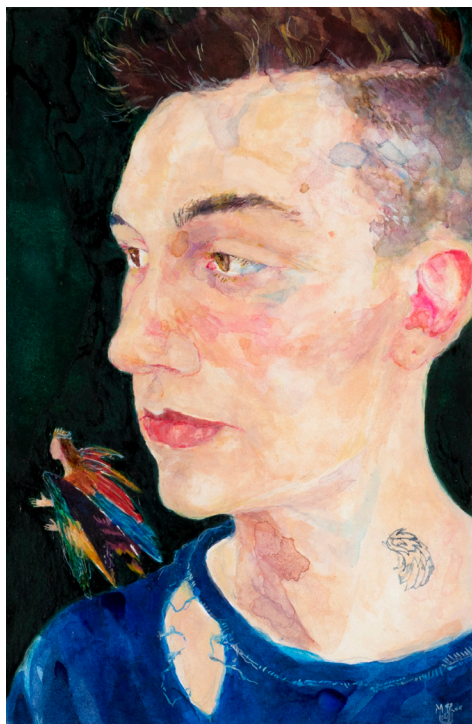
